The reigning national champion had quite a challenging opponent in the first round of YONEX-SUNRISE Hong Kong Open.

Saina Nehwal from India has an Olympic bronze medal from 2012 and a world championship medal in silver from 2015, but on Wednesday morning, local Hong Kong time, she was "just" Mette Poulsen's opponent.

- I did feel surprisingly well in there. I actually felt like I was in control for the most parts of the match. I was well prepared for her strengths and put up a tough defense on court, Poulsen, 24, says to Badminton Europe.

Her focus and calm game on court made the match a close affair which unfortunately ended with an Indian victory; 21-19, 23-21.






