Olympic Games, World Championships, European Games (or CG) or European Championships (or CC) Senior/Junior HP players from level A, B, C and D





**Elite-level development from Badminton Europe** 

Badminton Europe announced in 2009 two new initiatives to help increase the level of elite badminton players in Europe.

- 1. To establish a network of Badminton Europe Certificated Training Centres.
- 2. To award scholarships to players to enable them to stay at Certificated Training Centres. Scholarships are for players who have the potential to qualify for future World Championships and the 2020 Olympic Games.




