## BEC Financial Regulations

Amendment of BEC Financial Regulations that changes BEC European Championships participation fees

The main goal - to support European Championships organizers

Why the change?

- To make hosting Major Events financially more beneficial
- Financial considerations
  - The European Championships entry fees have not changed over 8 years
  - At the same time BEC Circuit tournament average entry fees have increased 34% (singles), 37% (doubles)
- To maintain and raise the organizing quality of European Championships

Proposed change to BEC Financial Regulation introduces participation fees which are shared by BEC and the host:

- With the current regulations (with the exception of European Senior Championships)
  BEC kept the full entry fee
- With the proposed change 1/3 of the participation fee goes to the host of the event. BEC retains 2/3 of the participation fee

Estimated indicative participation fees for hosts:

- European Championships, European Men's & Women's Team Championships and European U15 Championships approximately 7.500 euro
- European U17 Championships and European Junior Championships approximately 18.000 Euro
- European Senior Championships approximately 40.000 Euro
