The Luxembourg Badminton Federation (FELUBA) is the national governing body for badminton in Luxembourg. It is responsible for overseeing the development, promotion, and organization of the sport both within the country and in support of our athletes competing internationally.

As part of its ongoing commitment to the development of badminton in Luxembourg, FELUBA launched its Pro-Club Project in 2018, a nationwide initiative aimed at strengthening club structures, improving coaching quality, and increasing participation across all age groups.

Within this framework, FELUBA is recruiting a Pro Coach / club technical Advisor to support the development of affiliated clubs and contribute to the federation's long-term strategic objectives. Depending on qualifications and experience, the successful candidate may also be involved in activities related to regional or national training programs.

This position offers an exciting opportunity to play a key role in the growth of badminton in Luxembourg by delivering high-quality coaching, supporting club development, and helping create a positive and dynamic sporting environment.

Main responsibilities :

- Plan, organize, and deliver structured badminton training sessions for players of different ages and levels, including youth, adults, and senior players.
- Develop and implement training plans on a weekly, monthly, and seasonal basis.
- Provide individual support to athletes, including technical and tactical guidance and performance monitoring.
- Accompany players to tournaments, training camps, and other badminton-related activities.
- Maintain regular communication with players, parents, club officials, and federation staff.
- Contribute to the development and implementation of club development projects.
- Promote a positive learning environment and uphold the values of fair play, respect, and sporting excellence.
- Collaborate closely with other coaches within the Pro-Club structure and participate in regular technical meetings organized by FELUBA.
- Support federation initiatives and, depending on qualifications and experience, contribute to regional or national training activities.

- Level 1 coaching certification (BWF, LuxQF Level 3, or equivalent).
- Strong technical, tactical, pedagogical, and organizational competencies related to badminton coaching.
- Ability to plan and deliver training sessions adapted to different age groups and performance levels.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, with the ability to work effectively with players, parents, volunteers, and club committees.
- Demonstrated autonomy, reliability, creativity, and a proactive attitude.
- Ability to work both independently and as part of a larger coaching team.
- Knowledge of at least one of Luxembourg's official languages (French, German, or Luxembourgish) is considered a strong asset.
- Possession of a valid Category B driving license and access to a personal vehicle are required.

Contract Details

- Employer: Fédération Luxembourgeoise de Badminton (FELUBA).
- Working Time: Part-time contract between 25 and 35 hours per week.
- Meetings, administrative duties, and preparation time are included within working hours.
- Contract Type: One-year fixed-term contract, renewable based on performance and organizational needs.
- Location: Luxembourg, with occasional travel for competitions, training camps, and federation activities.
- Salary: Depending on qualifications, experience, and working hours. For a 30-hour contract, the salary ranges between EUR 2,500 and EUR 2,700 gross per month.
